

Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter Term 2



Learning Journey – History, Geography, Science & DT

This term the children will be answering the question, 'What was life like for a child in **WW2?'** This learning journey will incorporate the children's history, geography, science and DT learning. In history children will be exploring what it was like to have an air raid shelter in their garden; why some children were evacuated and how the war has impacted our lives today. The children will have the opportunity to learn about the Kinder Transport when they take their trip to the Holocaust Centre. Science will be focused on electricity and how its used to send communications while DT this term will be exploring food during the war. The children will learn all about rationing and the real life implications of this when trying to cook. They shall explore the seasonality of ingredients and then use this knowledge to create, evaluate and recreate a biscuit.
