We look forward to working with you all for another happy, hard working and fun year at White's Wood!



## Curriculum

At White's Wood, we continue to use a Learning Journey approach to the curriculum. Each journey is jam-packed with exciting lessons that lead children through their learning. They begin with a Learning Ouestion and their subsequent lessons will take them on a path through a topic. This will lead to them producing some amazing outcomes from their learning, which we will continue to share on social media. Please encourage your child to discuss their THE LEARNING JOURNEY learning at home as this will help them to develop their memory.

This term's learning questions are:

Year 3: Who was the better Tudor monarch, Henry VIII or Elizabeth I? Year 4: What impact did the Romans have on Britain?

Year 5: How have humans adapted to the physical geography of America? Year 6: Why is it called the World War and how was Britain defended?

## Attendance

While we will always work with you on improving attendance, we must remind parents that we cannot authorise holidays and must promote excellent attendance for all pupils. Poor attendance can lead to fines by the Local Authority and unfortunately we recently saw some extreme cases result in hefty fines (totalling over £12,000) imposed on families. We will always be here to support you long before it gets to that point so please do work with us and we can help to avoid these situations.

#### Permissions

We will ask for parental permissions for several things such as the use of photos on our social media platforms, watching appropriate film clips to support learning and for local area school trips. These need to be given (every year) on Arbor so please make sure you do this to allow us to run things more smoothly & to avoid being disturbed to give your permission for something at a later date.
