School PE kit and footwear

Dear Parents & Carers,

I am writing due to a large number of pupils continually wearing incorrect kit for PE. The correct kit is not only part of our compulsory school uniform but is also vital to ensure the safety of children when playing sport.

As you will know, PE is a statutory part of a child's education. The correct clothing is essential in order for children to take part in PE lessons. Our PE kit consists of:

- A plain white t-shirt
- Turquoise, black or navy sports shorts
- Appropriate footwear (trainers or plimsolls)
- Black or navy tracksuit bottoms and top (for outdoor PE, if required)

These items are all available from Uniform Direct (Market Street, Gainsborough, Tel: 01427 616105, Website: <u>www.uniform-direct.com</u>) as well as other stores such as ADSA Living, Morrison's and Tesco.

Due to the health and safety of pupils being paramount to us all, if children do not have the appropriate footwear for PE, **they will be unable to take part** in their lessons at school.

Additionally, please remember the following rules:

- Children should not wear jewellery in school, as it is inappropriate for PE
- Long hair must always be tied up for PE.
