Learning Journey – History, Geography, Science & DT

How essential is the River Nile to life in Ancient Egypt?

In History, the children will develop their understanding of primary and secondary sources while diving deeper into life during the time of the ancient Egyptians. In Science, last term's learning around the life cycle will continue by taking a closer look at mammals, insects and amphibians. In Geography, the children will continue to look at various types of maps so that they can compare Egypt and England. DT this term, will require the pupils to gain an understanding of a pulley system and apply it to the production of a shaduf.



PSHE

Our SCARF unit this half term is **Rights and Responsibility**. The children will be learning about making their rights, while understanding the different roles and responsibilities that they, and others, have in society. Throughout this unit, the children will also gain a better understanding of information sources and how can ensure that they are gaining knowledge from reliable places.
