

Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter Term 2

Learning Journey – History, Geography, Science & DT

This term the children will be answering the question, 'What was life like for a child in WW2?' This learning journey will incorporate the children's history, geography, science and DT learning. In history children will be exploring what it was like to have an air raid shelter in their garden; why some children were evacuated and how, and how the war has impacted our lives today. Science will be focused on electricity and how it's used to send communications while DT this term will be exploring food and recipes during the war. The children will learn about rationing and the real life implications of this when trying to cook. They shall explore the seasonality of ingredients and then use this knowledge to create, evaluate and adapt a biscuit recipe.
