

<u>Year 3.</u> <u>Autumn Term 2.</u> Curriculum Newsletter.

Learning Journey: Geography, Design & Technology (DT) and Science.

This term, the children will be answering the question, 'Why would you chose Lincolnshire to build your farm?'. In Geography, we will be using maps to locate cities and counties in the UK as well as learning about Lincolnshire in more detail. In DT, we will be looking at foods that are produced and grown in Lincolnshire and will be sampling a selection of foods as well as focusing on what is a varied, balanced diet. We will be using our skills of peeling, cutting and mashing to create a sausage and mash meal before evaluating it. In Science, we will be investigating types of rocks and soils to understand why Lincolnshire is so good for farming.







Religious Education (RE). Has Christmas lost its true meaning?

This term, we are learning to find out what the true meaning of Christmas is to Christians and compare this with what Christmas means to us. We will be reading the Christmas story as well as making a class Christmas tree with decorations to show all of the non-Christian and Christian aspects of Christmas.

Physical Education (PE).

This term, we will be focusing on Gymnastics and Fitness. As part of our warm-ups, we will be developing our speed, strength, co-ordination, agility, balance and stamina. In Gymnastics, we are going to be creating interesting point and patches balances, different types of jumps using the apparatus, learning different types of rolls as well as creating a sequence individually and with a partner.
